Continuing Education Scholarship for Minority REALTORS® in their First Renewal (2022-2024)

Scholarship:

- The scholarship entitles the recipient to one (1) MCE Season Pass (Value \$125) offered by the Association of REALTORS® school.
- The award has no residual value.
- The scholarship is not transferable and expires on May 31, 2024.
- The scholarship applies to in person and virtual live streaming education only.

Eligibility:

- Must be a minority REALTOR® member of Tri-County Suburban REALTORS® engaged full-time in real estate in their First PA License Renewal Cycle requiring education [i.e., eligible for the Commission-developed 14-hour required course for new licensees]
- Scholarships are not awarded retroactively.
- Applicant may not have been previously awarded a scholarship from Tri-County Suburban REALTORS® or the Association of REALTORS® School.

Application deadline:

- Up to two (2) scholarships may be awarded every two months to minority REALTOR® members of Tri-County Suburban REALTORS® for use between July 1, 2023, and May 31, 2024.
- Email your application to ptansey@tcsr.realtor on or before June 15, 2023; August 15, 2023; October 15, 2023; December 15, 2023; or February 15, 2024.
- Only completed applications will be considered.
- All applicants will be notified of the status of their application.
- If NOT awarded, applicant will be advised if they are eligible to resubmit for the next scholarship period.

If scholarship is awarded:

- Recipient will use the scholarship (MCE Season Pass) for the required 14-hour course for new licensees "Real World Real Estate".
- Recipient will use the scholarship (MCE Season Pass) to complete a MINIMUM of 7 additional hours over and above the required course.
- Recipient must follow all school policies, including but not limited to, attendance.
- Recipient will participate in follow up communication with a member of staff and/or the TCSR Diversity and Inclusion Committee about their experience with education and as a REALTOR® generally for the purposes of identifying needs and providing support and/or support resources for Recipient and other minority REALTORS®
